## University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill

- **The Nation's first state university, founded in 1793**
- The University offers 78 bachelor's, 112 master's, 68 doctorate and seven professional degree programs through 14 schools and the College of Arts and Sciences.
- More than 29,000 undergraduate, graduate and professional students learn from a faculty of 3,600.
- Carolina's 317,000 alumni live in all 50 states and more than 150 countries.
- Kiplinger's Personal Finance magazine ranked Carolina the #1 Best Combination of Top-Flight Academics and Affordable Costs in American public higher education for the 16th time.
- UNC was ranked the 5th best public university in the country in the *U.S. News & World Report* 2017 "Best Colleges" guidebook. This is 16th consecutive year UNC has made this list.
- #1 among major U.S. universities in the percentage of African-American students in the first-year class, according to *The Journal of Blacks in Higher Education*, for six of the previous nine years
- **Diverse student population** - Admitted first-year students hail from all 100 North Carolina counties, 41 states, the District of Columbia and 19 other countries
- **The Carolina Covenant** provides a debt-free education to qualified low-income students from North Carolina and beyond, is a national model for making a college degree possible for qualified low-income students. To date, more than 1,500 UNC students have benefited from the program.
