## Notice of Attorney or Non-Attorney Representation

In accordance with N.C.G.S. 116-40.11, students or student organizations accused of violations outlined in Housing and Residential Education's Community Living Standards may be represented, at their own expense, by a licensed attorney or non-attorney advocate of their own choosing.

Any student that is represented by an attorney or non-attorney advocate during the Housing conduct process must submit this completed form to the Housing and Residential Education office prior to any hearing. Additionally, an involved student must also complete and sign a release of information form providing consent for the disclosure of University records maintained by Housing and Residential Education under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
