Any student that is represented by an attorney or non-attorney advocate during the Housing conduct process must submit this completed form to Carolina Housing via their Hearing Officer prior to any hearing. Additionally, an involved student must also complete and sign a release of information form providing consent for the disclosure of University records maintained by Carolina Housing under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
